1. Standby Funds

- ₱748.73 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 161,509 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 77,241 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 84,268 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 49,011 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱352.32 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.






b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)
