

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Buli, Muntinlupa City as of 21 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 February 2023 at around 11:49 AM, a fire incident occurred at Nos. 285, 287, and 289 cor. Concepcion Rd., Brgy. Buli, Muntinlupa City. The fire was declared out at around 1PM.
