	The Social Welfare and Development (SWAD) Team and City Action Team (CAT) of DSWD FO V were immediately activated to respond to the affected families.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO V for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
