I. Situation Overview

On 19 February 2023 at around 9:31 AM, a fire incident occurred at St. Paul St., Brgy. Moonwalk, Parañaque City. The fire was declared out at around 10:24 AM.

- ₱335.76 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
