On 18 February 2023 at around 10:28 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Pantok, Binangonan, Rizal. The fire was declared out on 19 February 2023 at around 12:40 AM.

- ₱5.5 million available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.

- 119,775 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 82,128 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 37,647 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 22,158 FFPs available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.
- ₱376.50 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO CALABARZON warehouses.
