I. Situation Overview

On 06 February 2023 at around 10:42 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Laray, Brgy. San Roque, Talisay City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 11:50 PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱758.09 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 124,464 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 38,358 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 86,106 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 32,022 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱381.62 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.

b. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

06 February 2023	The DRMD Disaster Response and Rehabilitation Section (DRRS) together with the City Action Team (CAT) of DSWD FO VII were deployed as workforce augmentation especially in the conduct of psychological first aid (PFA).
