

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tubod, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte as of 27 February 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 26 February 2023, a fire incident occurred at Purok San Antonio, Brgy. Tubod, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte. The Disaster Response Information and Management Section-Disaster Response Management Division (DRIMS-DRMD) of the DSWD FO X received the report for the said incident at around 8:45 AM. The fire was declared out at around 5:12 PM.

A total of **51 families** or **185 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tubod, Iligan City** (see Table 1).
