I. Situation Overview

On 18 February 2023 at around 12:50 AM, a fire incident occurred at Kalayaan St., Brgy. Ususan, Taguig City. The fire was declared out at around 3:30 AM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱748.73 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 146,483 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 84,536 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 61,947 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 8,369 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱335.27 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
