

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flashflood Incidents in Sarangani

as of 02 February 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 30 January 2023 at around 1PM, Municipalities in Sarangani experienced flashfloods and flooding caused by the overflowing of rivers and creeks due to Shear Line and localized thunderstorms.

A total of **114 families** or **567 persons** are affected in **five (5) barangays** in the **Sarangani** (see Table 1).
