

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Batad, Iloilo

as of 03 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 January 2023 at around 12 NN, several barangays in the Municipality of Batad in Iloilo experienced flooding due to continuous heavy rains. The flood subsided at around 1:45 PM.

A total of **23 families** or **92 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Batad, Iloilo** (see Table 1).
