

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Davao City as of 22 February 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2023 at around 9PM, residents from low-lying areas in several barangays in Davao City experienced flooding due to localized thunderstorms.

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **773 families** or **3,069 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **10 evacuation centers** in **Davao City** (see Table 2).

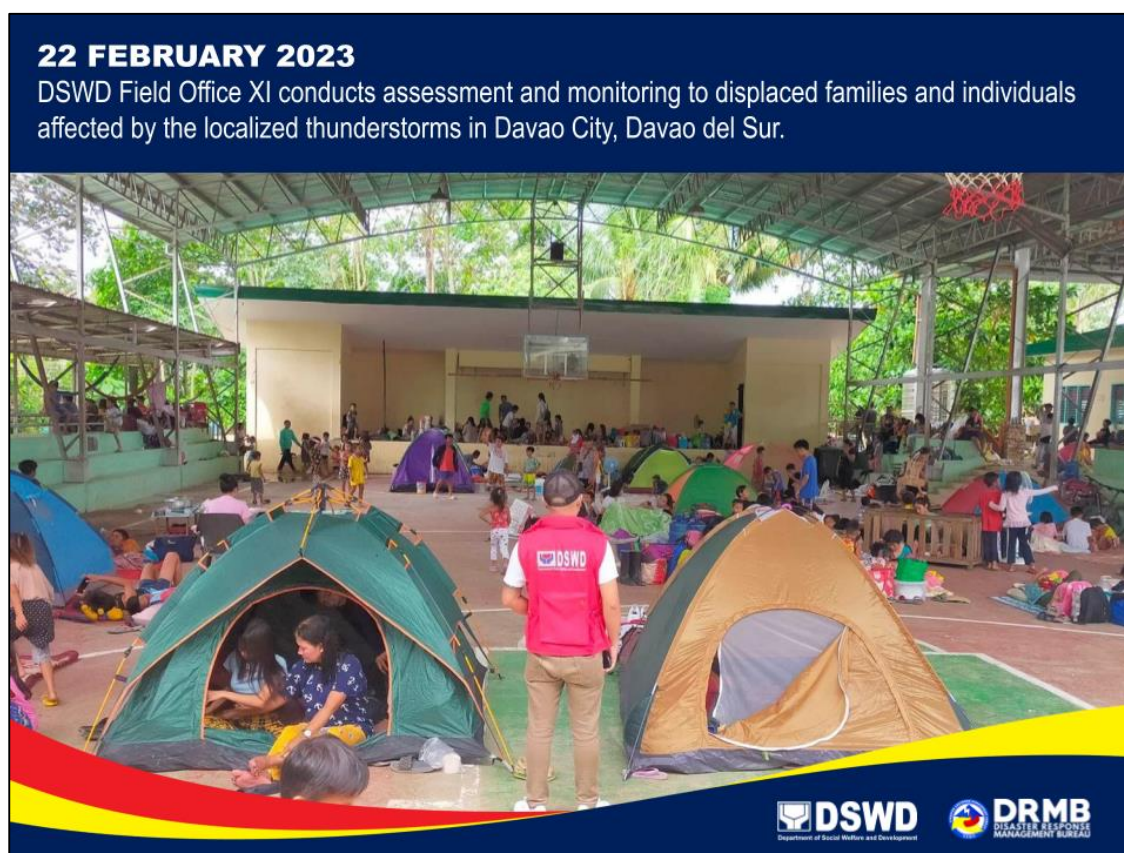
