



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Davao City

as of 22 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2023 at around 9PM, residents from low-lying areas in several barangays in Davao City experienced flooding due to localized thunderstorms.

A total of 1,139 families or 4,256 persons are affected in five (5) barangays in Davao City (see Table 1).

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 102,977 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 85,530 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 17,447 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 14,956 FFPs available at DSWD FO XI.
- ₱348.23 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XI warehouses.


c. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)
