

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Roxas City, Capiz as of 26 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 February 2023 at around 5:55 AM, several barangays in Roxas City, Capiz experienced flooding due to Localized Thunderstorms.
