

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Zamboanga City as of 01 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 31 January 2023 at around 2PM, several barangays in Zamboanga City experienced flooding due to continuous heavy rains brought by localized thunderstorms.

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **762 families** or **3,810 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **seven (7) evacuation centers** in **Zamboanga City** (see Table 2).
