#### I. Situation Overview

On 31 January 2023 at around 2PM, several barangays in Zamboanga City experienced flooding due to continuous heavy rains brought by localized thunderstorms.

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **762 families** or **3,810 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **seven (7) evacuation centers** in **Zamboanga City** (see Table 2).

#### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 91,977 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 26,671 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 65,306 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 43,592 FFPs available at DSWD FO IX.
- ₱390.18 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO IX warehouses.
