I. Situation Overview

On 04 February 2023 at around 4:30 PM, an armed conflict transpired between the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and members of the New People's Army (NPA) in Brgy. Oringao, Kabankalan City, Negros Occidental.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱758.09 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 121,266 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 36,760 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 84,506 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 48,721 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱357.24 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

The City Action Team (CAT) in Kabankalan City hauled and distributed FFPs and other non-food items to affected families and individuals.
