## I. Situation Overview

On 06 February 2023, an armed conflict transpired in Calbayog City, Samar between the troops of Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines - New People's Army (CPP-NPA).

A total of **981 families** or **4,905 persons** are affected in **11 barangays** in **Calbayog City**, **Samar** (see Table 1).
