

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sucat, Muntinlupa City as of 28 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 February 2023 at around 12:44 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Sucat, Muntinlupa City. It was declared fire out at around 2:04 PM. The cause of the fire is still under investigation.
