

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 649, Manila City as of 23 February 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 17 February 2023 at around 1:51 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 649, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 4:53 PM.
