I. Situation Overview

On 17 February 2023 at around 1:51 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 649, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 4:53 PM.

- ₱748.73 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 104,575 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 87,128 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 17,447 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 9,443 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱337.57 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
