

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flashflood Incidents in Sarangani

as of 03 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 30 January 2023 at around 1PM, Municipalities in Sarangani experienced flashfloods and flooding caused by the overflowing of rivers and creeks due to Shear Line and localized thunderstorms.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **937 families** or **4,070 persons** are affected in **nine (9) barangays** in **Sarangani** (see Table 1).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **23 families** or **116 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Sarangani** (see Table 2).
