

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flooding Incident in Davao Region as of 23 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2023 at around 9PM, residents from low-lying areas in several Municipalities in Davao Region experienced flooding due to localized thunderstorms.

A total of **12,623 families** or **54,788 persons** are affected in **18 barangays** in **Davao Region** (see Table 1).
