I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2023 at around 9PM, residents from low-lying areas in several Municipalities in Davao Region experienced flooding due to localized thunderstorms. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) XI

A total of **12,623 families** or **54,788 persons** are affected in **18 barangays** in **Davao Region** (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱748.73 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 104,575 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 87,128 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 17,447 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 14,956 FFPs available at DSWD FO XI.
- ₱350.76 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XI warehouses.
