## I. Situation Overview

On 31 January 2023 at around 2PM, several barangays in Zamboanga City experienced flooding due to continuous heavy rains brought by localized thunderstorms.

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **762 families** or **3,810 persons** took temporary shelter in **seven (7)** evacuation centers in Zamboanga City (see Table 2).

- 120,067 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 35,561 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 84,506 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
