

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Mw 6.0 Earthquake Incident in Compostela, Davao De Oro as of 03 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 February 2023 at 6:44 PM, a 6.0-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of Compostela (Davao De Oro) (07.66°N, 126.07°E - 002 km S 66° W) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus 017 km. The earthquake was also felt in the neighboring municipalities.
