I. Situation Overview

On 02 February 2023, the troops of the 95th Infantry Battalion under the Operational Control of 501st Infantry Brigade conducted an intensified military operation to eradicate insurgents in Cagayan which resulted to a firefight against a local communist terrorist group within the vicinity of Brgy. Hacienda Intal, Baggao, Cagayan.


