

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Sta. Margarita, Baggao, Cagayan

as of 27 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 February 2023, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Daligalig, Brgy. Sta. Margarita, Baggao, Cagayan between the troops of the 17th Infantry Battalion and the 15 members of the Komiteng Probinsiya Cagayan, Komiteng Rehiyon-Cagayan Valley.

A total of **193 families** or **700 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Baggao, Cagayan** (see Table 1).
