04 February 2023	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The LGU of Lapu-Lapu City provided hot meals and medical assistance to the affected families and referred the injured individuals to the hospital.

05 February 2023	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> DSWD FO VII closely coordinated with the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) of the LGU of Lapu-Lapu City relative to their request of relief items.
04 February 2023	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The CSWDO of the LGU of Lapu-Lapu City conducted intake interviews and profiling of the affected families. DSWD FO VII closely coordinated with the CSWDO of the LGU of Lapu-Lapu City for the assessment of affected families, provision of technical assistance on camp coordination and camp management (CCCM), and internally displaced person (IDP) protection, and any request of relief augmentation.
