I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2023 at around 3:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Lower Acharon, Brgy. Calumpang, General Santos City.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱748.73 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 120,075 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 70,728 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 49,347 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 44,477 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱377.13 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

DATE	ACTIVITIES
01 March 2023	DSWD FO XII distributed FNIs such as family kit, kitchen kit, and sleeping kit to the affected families.
22 February 2023	DSWD FO XII conducted field validation and assessment, and provided FFPs to the affected families.
21 February 2023	 The City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) of the LGU of General Santos City together with the Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Committee (BDRRMC) of Barangay Calumpang facilitated the transfer of the displaced families to the evacuation center and provided them with food packs and hot meals. DSWD FO XII distributed FFPs to the families affected by the fire incident.





c. Internally Displaced Person (IDP) Protection

21 February 2023	 The CSWDO of the LGU of General Santos City conducted Psychological First Aid / Critical Incident Stress Debriefing session to the affected families and individuals.

d. Other Activities

03 March 2023	 DSWD FO XII continuously coordinates with the LGU of General Santos City for significant updates and any request of relief augmentation.
01 March 2023	 The LGU of General Santos City provided ₱15,000.00 financial assistance to each of the affected families.
