## I. Situation Overview

On 28 January 2023 at around 4:37 AM, a fire incident occurred in Barangays West Habog-Habog and San Juan in Molo, Iloilo City. It was declared fire out at around 6:16 AM.

### 1. Standby Funds

#### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 106,374 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 29,868 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 76,506 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 48,721 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱352.52 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.

#### b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

28 January 2023	DSWD FO VI in coordination with the LGU of Iloilo City facilitated the hauling of the initial relief augmentation comprised of 300 FFPs, 40 hygiene kits, 40 sleeping kits, 40 family kits, and 40 kitchen kits intended for the affected families. The distribution of these relief items were spearheaded by DSWD FO VI Regional Director Carmelo N. Nochete, Assistant Regional Director for Operations Arwin O. Razo, and Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) Officer-in-Charge (OIC)-Chief Judith T. Barredo.

#### c. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

31 January 2023	DSWD FO VI through its DRMD-Disaster Response and Rehabilitation Section (DRRS) assisted the CSWDO of the LGU of Iloilo City in the management of internally displaced persons (IDPs), distribution of FNIs, and validation of affected families and persons.




