as of 24 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2023 at around 9PM, residents from low-lying areas in several Municipalities in Davao Region experienced flooding due to localized thunderstorms. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) XI

A total of **14,154 families** or **61,524 persons** are affected in **19 barangays** in **Davao Region** (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱748.73 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 109,275 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 82,128 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 27,147 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 9,456 FFPs available at DSWD FO XI.
- ₱350.37 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XI warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

23 February 2023	 DSWD FO XI provided food and non-food items such as family food packs, hygiene kits, sleeping kits, and additional modular tents to the affected families.
22 February 2023	 DSWD FO XI provided modular tents to the Municipality of Carmen, Davao del Norte intended for the displaced families and individuals. The LGU of Davao City provided FNIs to displaced families and individuals.
