

DSWD DROMIC Report #35 on the Effects of Shear Line as of 04 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 26 December 2022, the Shear Line continuously affected Visayas and the northern portion of Mindanao while the Northeast Monsoon affected Luzon.

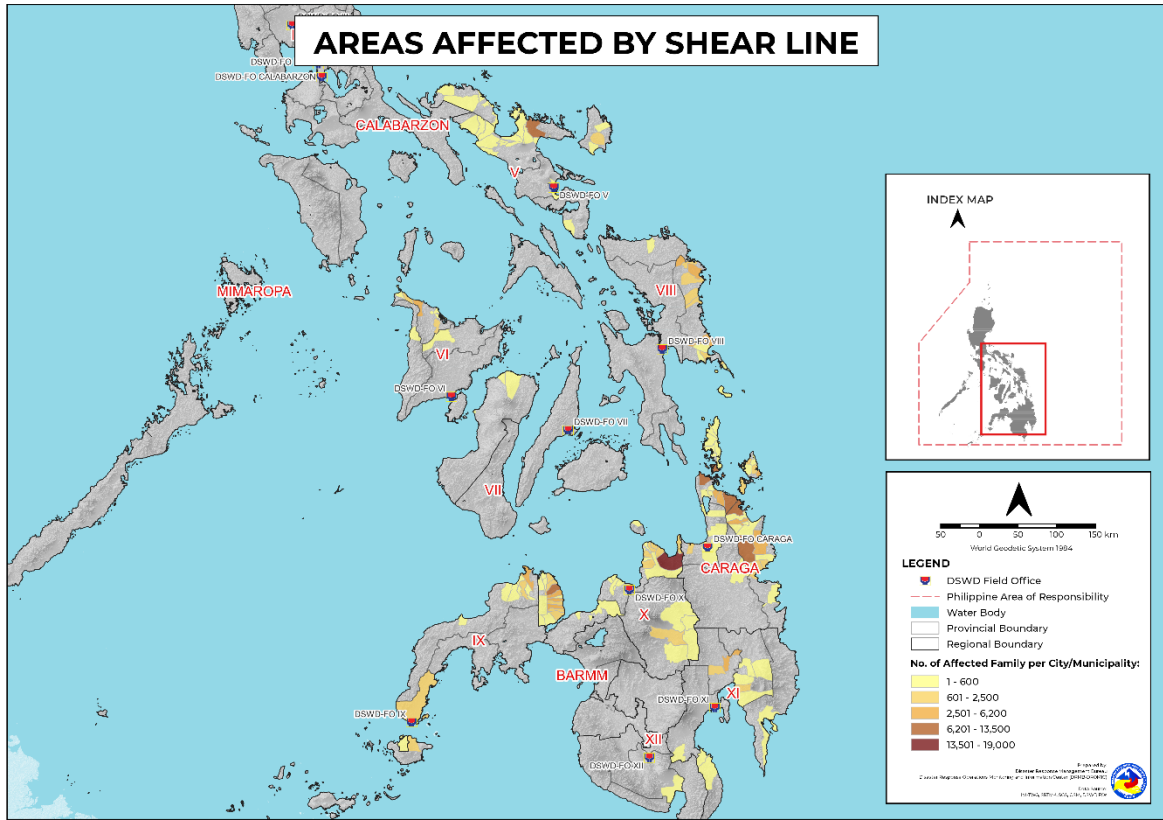

There are **457 families** or **1,774 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **30 evacuation centers** in **Regions V, IX, X, and Caraga** (see Table 2).
