



DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Oringao, Kabankalan City, Negros Occidental

as of 09 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 February 2023 at around 4:30 PM, an armed conflict transpired between the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and members of the New People's Army (NPA) in Brgy. Oringao, Kabankalan City, Negros Occidental.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **285 families** or **948 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Oringao**, **Kabankalan City**, **Negros Occidental** (see Table 1).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **285 families** or **948 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Covered Court** in **Brgy. Oringao**, **Kabankalan City**, **Negros Occidental** (see Table 2). These families have returned to their respective residences after the safety clearance from the Philippine Army was issued.

A total of \$\mathbb{P}\$1,462,812.50 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}\$1,442,812.50 from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}\$20,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Table 3).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱758.09 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 145,516 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 54,748 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 90,768 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 50.031 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱355.73 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

05 February 2023	 DSWD FO VII through its Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) coordinated with the LGU of Kabankalan City for the provision of relief items. The City Action Team (CAT) in Kabankalan City hauled and distributed FFPs and other non-food items to affected families and individuals. The City Social Welfare Development Office (CSWDO) of the LGU of Kabankalan City continuously provided the affected families and individuals with hot meals and other basic needs.





c. Other Activities

DATE	ACTIVITIES
08 February 2023	DSWD FO VI through its DRMD and CAT continuously coordinated with the CSWDO of the LGU of Kabankalan City for significant disaster response updates and any request of relief augmentation.
06 February 2023	DSWD FO VI deployed staff to Kabankalan City to further assess the needs and status of the affected families and to provide technical assistance to the LGU on Disaster Assistance Family Access Card (DAFAC) data generation.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO VI for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.

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
