



DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Flooding Incident in Davao Region

as of 25 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2023 at around 9PM, residents from low-lying areas in several Municipalities in Davao Region experienced flooding due to localized thunderstorms.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱748.73 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 109,275 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 82,128 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 27,147 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 9,456 FFPs available at DSWD FO XI.
- ₱360.32 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XI warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)
