

## DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Flooding Incident in Davao Region as of 25 February 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2023 at around 9PM, residents from low-lying areas in several Municipalities in Davao Region experienced flooding due to localized thunderstorms.
