



# **DSWD DROMIC Report #5 on the Flooding Incident in Davao Region**

as of 27 February 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2023 at around 9 PM, residents from low-lying areas in several Municipalities in Davao Region experienced flooding due to localized thunderstorms.


## **27 FEBRUARY 2023**
