

DSWD DROMIC Report #5 on the Flooding Incident in Davao Region as of 27 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2023 at around 9 PM, residents from low-lying areas in several Municipalities in Davao Region experienced flooding due to localized thunderstorms.

A total of **13,279 families** or **56,585 persons** are affected in **19 barangays** in **Davao Region** (see Table 1).
