



DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Molo, Iloilo City

21 April 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 January 2023 at around 4:37 AM, a fire incident occurred in Barangays West Habog-Habog and San Juan in Molo, Iloilo City. It was declared fire out at around 6:16 AM.

A total of **300 families** or **1,139 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Molo, lloilo City** (see Table 1).
