

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incident in Batad, Iloilo

29 March 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 January 2023 at around 12 NN, several barangays in the Municipality of Batad in Iloilo experienced flooding due to continuous heavy rains. The flood subsided at around 1:45 PM.
