

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Tension Cracks due to Impending Landslide in Barili, Cebu

11 April 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 January 2023, tension cracks were observed on the roads in Brgy. Maigang, Barili, Cebu. On 17 January 2023, the Local Disaster Risk and Reduction and Management Office (LDRRMO) in coordination with the Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB) inspected the site as well as areas in the nearby barangay.

On 03 February 2023 at 4:45 PM, the MGB released a Landslide Threat Advisory and further recommended preemptive evacuation of families residing in the affected areas. However, the residents refused to leave their house. Most of the families have eventually evacuated during the force evacuation conducted by the LGU of Barili, Cebu on 05 February 2023.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **49 families** or **187 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Barili, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **12 families** or **60 persons** sought temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Barili, Cebu** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **24 families** or **88 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **36 families** or **148 persons** were displaced in **Barili, Cebu** (see Annex D).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱889,042.50** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱164,537.50** from **DSWD** and **₱130,210.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
