I. Situation Overview

On 11 December 2022 at around 5:39 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the Philippine National Police (PNP) and the New People's Army (NPA) in Brgy. Aningalan, San Remigio, Antique.

A total of **779 families** or **4,283 persons** are affected in **five (5) barangays** in **San Remigio, Antique** (see Table 1).

- ₱359.84 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
