

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Hanopol Norte, Balilihan, Bohol

as of 11 March 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 09 March 2023 at around 5PM, an armed conflict transpired between the forces of the 47th Infantry Battalion (IB) of the Philippine Army and members of the New People's Army at Sitio Lusad, Purok 3, Brgy. Hanopol Norte, Balilihan, Bohol.

A total of **33 families** or **125 persons** are affected in **Sitio Lusad, Purok 3, Brgy. Hanopol Norte, Balilihan, Bohol** (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱704.46 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 89,151 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 24,704 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 64,447 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.

- 41,166 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱382.59 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.
