

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Capsized Fishing Banca in Brgy. Magsidel, Calayan

as of 03 March 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 25 February 2023 at around 6AM, a non-motorized fishing banca capsized at the water vicinities in Brgy. Magsidel, Calayan, Cagayan due to severe weather conditions.

### 1. Standby Funds

- ₱748.73 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱3.58 million available at DSWD FO II.

### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 120,075 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 70,728 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 49,347 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 40,575 FFPs available at DSWD FO II.
- ₱368.28 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO II warehouses.
