

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Displacement due to the Joint Police Operation in Brgy. Kimlawis, Kiblawan, Davao del Sur as of 18 March 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

From 20 February to 17 March 2023, the Davao del Sur Police Provincial Office (DSPPO) and Kiblawan Municipal Police Station (MPS) conducted a joint operation in Brgy. Kimlawis, Kiblawan, Davao del Sur to implement the Simultaneous Anti-Criminality Law Enforcement Operation (SACLEO). As a result, families and individuals voluntarily left their houses to take shelter in safer grounds.
