2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 80,820 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 34,173 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 46,647 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 6,889 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱268.15 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
