- ₱268.15 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.

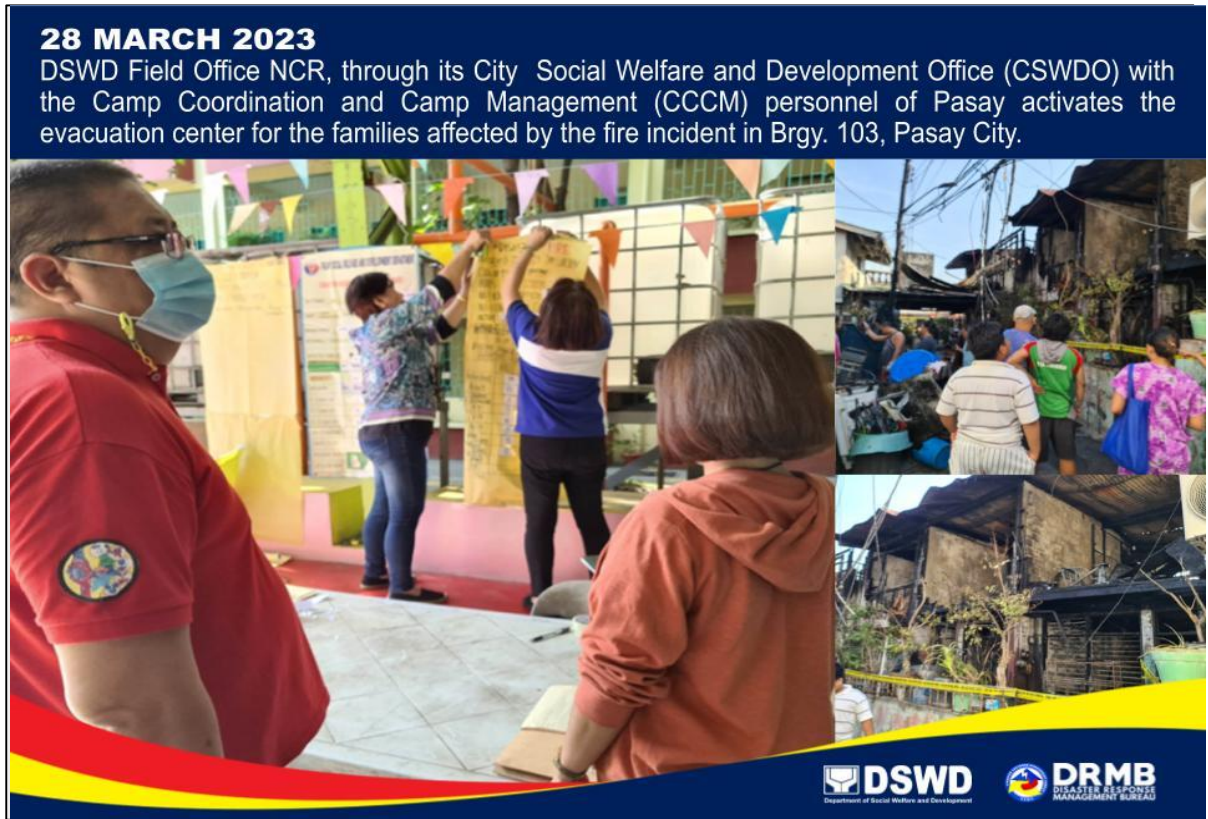
