

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 35, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

as of 28 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 22 February 2023 at around 1:10 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 35, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. According to the Bacolod City Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), the cause of fire was allegedly due to unattended cookstove. The fire was declared out at around 1:20 PM.
