I. Situation Overview

On 19 March 2023 at around 10:27 PM, a fire incident occurred at Onyx St., Brgy. 767, San Andres, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 12:17 AM.

- ₱328.90 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
