#### I. Situation Overview

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 10 families or 50 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Gymnasium in Brgy. Bula, General Santos City (see Table 2).

A total of \$\mathbb{P}163,062.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}153,062.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}10,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Table 4).

- 121,471 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 67,324 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 54,147 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 44,069 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
