- 104,819 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 38,672 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 66,147 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 55,638 FFPs available at DSWD FO II.
- ₱357.07 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO II warehouses.
